This article describes how customer **authorizes** and provides **Azure Tenant ID/Domain** to Getac for Windows Autopilot device registration.


## 1. Windows Autopilot customer consent:

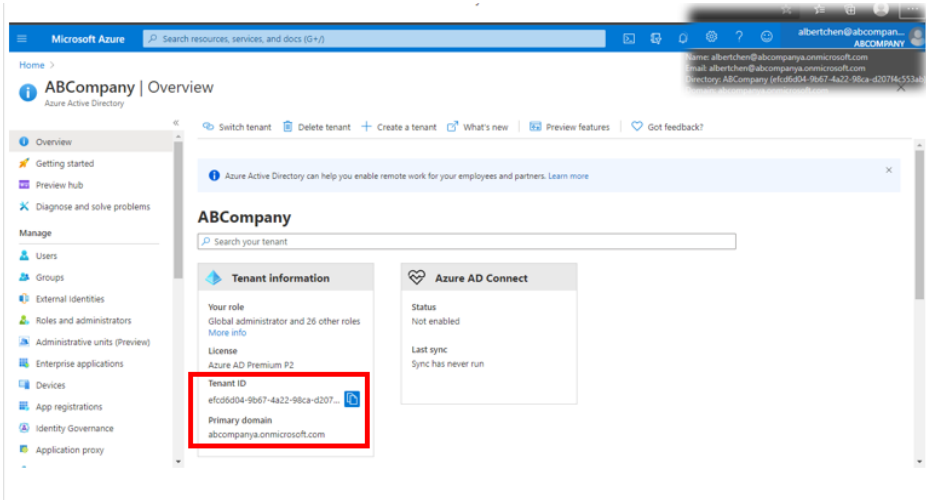
## 2. To Provide Azure Tenant ID/Domain information to Getac for the first time of order (if no information differences)

- To find your Azure Active Directory Tenant ID/Domain
  - a. Access the Microsoft Azure Portal (<https://portal.azure.com>)
  - b. After logged in, click “Azure Active Directory”



- c. When you are in Azure Active Directory page, your **Azure Active Directory Tenant ID/Domain** will be shown in the red box as below:
